

SUGGESTION FOR 3 NIGHT ITINERARY DOWNSTREAM

Day One

Board the houseboat at 3pm at Apex River Beach Holiday Park. Next you will be introduced to the facilities on board, and given a comprehensive driving and mooring lesson before you relax and settle in to life on board.

This afternoon you could explore upstream to Mildura Homestead and Lock Island (approx 1.5hr). On Lock Island you will find the history of the Murray River lock system.

Day Two

Continue on downstream for approximately 1.5 hours. Enjoy lunch at the River Road café. This is one of Mildura's best kept secrets, with a large range of gifts, homewares and furniture in the adjacent shop.

Travel downstream towards Coomealla, approximately 2 hours cruising from River Road. Mooring is available at the Coomealla Golf Club for the evening. A great photo opportunity for overseas visitors is when the kangaroos come down to graze on the fairway at sunset. For a meal or a flutter on the pokies visit the Coomealla Services club. A courtesy bus is available to pick up and drop off from your moorings.

Day Three

Today you can enjoy a round of golf on the championship golf course. Non golfers can take a walk and enjoy the wildlife of possums, kangaroos, goanna etc.

Start your journey back towards Apex park, maybe enjoy a camp fire beside one of the sandbars.

Day Four

Cruise back up the river in time for a 10am departure, after a great short break.
